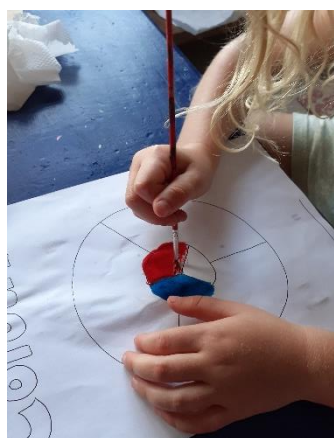


IMAJEN Water-colour

The colour-wheel

- Start with “Umph” ... use water and a little bit of effort to work the paint into a juicy consistency.
- Paint in the primary colours (red, blue and yellow)
- Paint in the secondary colours (orange, green and purple) by mixing the primary colours.
- Clean paint with a damp tissue.



- Mixing colours is great fun... look at the different types of secondary colours that you can create... encourage your children to see different tones and describe where they have seen this colour before...



Activity ideas:

- Use watercolour to ‘match’ tones of leaves from the garden.
- Use watercolour paint to explain the water cycle or photosynthesis...
